<b>Mt 5:29-30</b>	Forsake the flesh and look to Christ	<b>1 Co 10:31-33</b>	Give no offense to anybody. Be imitators of Christ ( <i>1 Co 11:1</i> )
<b>Ro 6:1-2</b>	Continue in sin? No!	<b>1 Co 15:33-34</b>	Bad companies corrupt good morals. Be sober-minded
<b>Jn 5:14</b>	Do not sin anymore	<b>2 Co 6:14 - 7:1</b>	Let us clean ourselves from all defilement
<b>Ro 7:18-21</b>	The conflict of two natures ( <i>Ga 5:16-17. 1 Jn 4:4</i> )	<b>2 Tim 2:19-21</b>	Abstain from wickedness
<b>1 Co 6:18-20</b>	You are not your own. You were bought with a price	<b>1 Co 10:6-13</b>	Let us not try the Lord. Make no provision for the flesh ( <i>Ro 13:14</i> )
<b>Ro 8:12</b>	We have no obligations to the flesh	<b>Ga 6:8,9</b>	Do not grow weary
<b>Eph 4:22-24</b>	Lay aside old self; put on new self	<b>1 Jn 2:1</b>	If we sin we have a defense attorney
<b>Ro 6:12-13</b>	Present yourselves as instruments of righteousness	<b>Heb 12:7</b>	God deals with us as sons (discipline)
<b>Eph 5:8-10</b>	Walk as children of light. Learn what is pleasing to God	<b>Heb 11</b>	Total faith
<b>Heb 12:1-4</b>	Set aside sin; set eyes on Jesus. Resist to death	<b>Heb 3:13</b>	Encourage one another so that none will be hardened
<b>1 P 5:8-9</b>	Be on alert. Resist the devil	<b>Tit 2:9-14</b>	Live sensibly, righteously and godly
<b>1 Thes 3:5</b>	Succumbing to the tempter makes the work of others useless	<b>2 Co 4:2</b>	By the manifestation of the truth commending ourselves
<b>1 Co 5:6-8</b>	Stop sinning. Celebrate with sincerity and truth	<b>Ga 5:13-16</b>	Serve one another
<b>Lk 17:1-2</b>	Little ones are around: be not a stumbling block	<b>1 Thes 4:3-12</b>	No to immorality; yes to brotherly love and work
